

Dress Code

At Bridgton Academy, we recognize that much can be reflected in a student's personal appearance, language, and behavior. The expectation for all students is that they abide by the rules set forth by the Academy and that they show respect for themselves and others at all times. One way we accomplish this is by instituting and following a dress code for both faculty and students.

Student Academic Dress

From 8:00 am to 3:00 pm, Monday through Friday, Academic Dress is required for faculty and students. This dress code requirement applies to the Hamlin STEM Center, Academy Building, Goldsmith Dining Hall, Humanities Center, and Chapel.

The dress code is:

- A collared shirt (button down, golf or polo style shirt are acceptable)
- Sweater
- Hooded or crew neck sweatshirt (if a student removes a sweatshirt, they must have a shirt with a collar on underneath)
- Khaki shorts/pants
- Jeans

Failure to comply with the Bridgton Academy dress code will result in the student being sent back to their room to change.

Academic day dress is non-athletic in nature. In addition, hats (athletic or winter) or hoods of any kind must be removed upon entering *all* buildings (with the exception of the Memorial Gym or dormitories).

Formal Student Dress

There are occasions throughout the academic year when more formal dress is required. These include special Chapel presentations, advisor dinners, awards banquets, athletic events, class presentations, and other functions that require a higher standard of dress for all students and faculty.

Formal student dress is the following:

- Suit coat or blazer
- Dress pants
- Dress shirt: button-down with collar
- Necktie
- Dress shoes and socks
