Registration will take place under the tent on the upper campus of Bridgton Academy. As you arrive, staff will greet you and direct you to the appropriate parking area. The registration process will involve visiting several stations including academics, residential life, and the student health center, before students move into their residence hall. **E&R Campus Laundry** will also be on hand for this event and day-of laundry plan sign-ups will be available for any interested families.

In the morning, grab-and-go coffee and refreshments will be offered under the tent, and lunch will be available for both students and guests on Registration Day as well.
