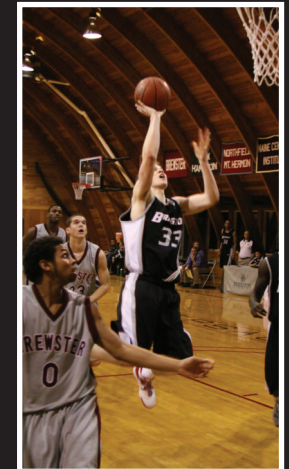
"The teachers, coaches, and advisors have paid more attention to me than anyone ever has at previous schools."
